

## **Worcester Divers** **Dive Trip Bookings**

All dive trips will be co-ordinated by the Diving Officer who will agree the outline plan for the trip with the organiser and the delegated Dive Manager.

All divers booked on a trip should be suitably qualified for that trip; this includes all necessary experience dives being completed as well as their QRB being "signed off". If an individual is not suitably qualified at the time of booking, it is their responsibility to ensure that they are by the time the trip date comes round.

To book on a trip, contact the trip organiser or the D/O

Price for RIB trips is £10 per diver per day plus a share of fuel, harbour fees, towing costs & any other group costs. A minimum group charge of £50 (5 divers) per day applies.

Price for hard-boat charters can vary considerably but will typically be approx. £40 - £50 per diver per day

Non members are welcome to join in on most club trips by invitation and at the discretion of the D/O & trip organiser. It should be understood that fully paid up Worcester Dive Club members get first option on all trips and that a non member should not take a place at the preference of a fully paid up member. Non members pay an additional £5 per diver per day for club RIB bookings.

A non-refundable deposit is required from all divers wishing to book on any trip.

For club RIB dives, a deposit of £10 per diver per trip is required. The amount of deposit required for hard-boat trips will be set by the trip organiser, the balance being payable prior to the date of the trip taking place. All deposits are non-refundable.

Except in extreme circumstances; having paid the deposit, if a diver is then unable to attend that trip for whatever reason, it will become that diver's responsibility to sell their place to another suitably qualified diver. The trip organiser can assist with this but is not responsible for it. If the place is not subsequently sold, then the cancelling diver may become liable for any incurred costs resulting from their opting out, this may include full payment of any outstanding balance for the vacated place.

This policy will also apply on any occasion when a diver "bails out" of a trip part way through after it has begun.
